The JCWSD would like to take this page to discuss the **Amsterdam Area Sewer System Project** and provide some information relating to the project and residential connections. Please reach out to the JCWSD at the contact information listed below if you have any additional questions.

- As of this writing, 70 of 400 connections have been successfully completed (18%).
- Some of the drain layers who originally expressed interest in completing connections have changed their minds. Updates to the drain layers list are posted on the Amsterdam Project page at www.jcwatersewer.com/amsterdam-sewers as soon as they become available.
- The Jefferson County Commissioners and the JCWSD are working to bring in additional drain layers to the area by placing advertisements in publications in neighboring counties.
- As of this writing, the Jefferson County connection deadline is to be determined. It currently stands at the end of December for Jefferson County Residents.
- The connection deadline for Carroll County residents is determined by the Carroll County Board of Health. Please contact them for more information.
- Residents receiving LMI Financial Assistance via RCAP must connect by the end of December 2022 in order to comply with the grant deadline.
- As of this writing, the date when unconnected customers will start receiving a bill is yet to be determined.
